Tuesday, February 25th, 11:30 AM – 1:30 PM



Remembering Mrs. Coleen Grant Hardin

Our dearly beloved Mrs. Hardin passed away peacefully at her home in Austin, TX in the loving care of her husband and family. She was 97 years of age and lived a rich and remarkable life that will be cherished and remembered by many. Coleen was heavily involved with UT's Drama Department when it had only been four years into the program, leading her to work with directors such as Margo Jones and Tennessee Williams. In 1942, while attending UT and participating in organizations such as The Curtain Club, she met her future



husband Dick Hardin. Three years later, upon his return from World War II, they wed in secret at the Pacific Theater in New York City - a "fancy elopement" she called it. After Dick was discharged from the Marines, the couple moved back to Austin, where she continued to perform for radio, theatre, and later for television. She has also written several books based off her family's genealogy. Mr. & Mrs. Hardin became members back in 2003 when Campus Club was located at Walter Webb Hall off 25th Street and continued their membership when we opened the AT&T Hotel and Conference Center in 2008. Not only did they visit every day for lunch, many of their birthdays and celebrations took place here. They would always bring a visitor with them and truly helped The Campus Club grow by referring many of our current members. In 1945 she had her daughter Lise and three years later her son Rick. At the tender age of 21, Lise



lost her life to Cystic Fibrosis, so she will greet her mother with open arms into the next world.
